

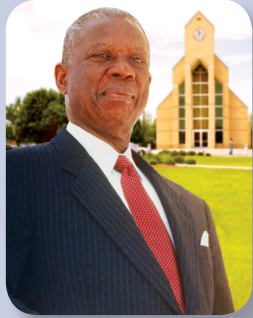

“Encouraging Scholastic Progress: The Power of You”

Mrs. Henegan delivers “profound” message during Alpha Kappa Alpha Founders Day celebration

“The power of one person with a vision...” were the first words uttered by Mrs. Patricia Moore Henegan on Thursday as she delivered her message, “Encouraging Scholastic Progress: The Power of You.”

Henegan, a retired educator, was the featured speaker for the annual Founders Day Celebration hosted by members of the Nu Gamma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated.

The message was clear - there is a great amount of power in each of us and we should embrace it.

As she shared the positive influence others have when they genuinely care, she stated, “They are the ones who want you to know it is

more honorable to fail than to cheat. They are the ones who want you to have faith in your own self even when others doubt you.” In outlining the many roles this generation will soon take over, Henegan told students, “It is your responsibility to step up to the plate and train the next generation.”

Prior to ending her message, students were encouraged to “do more than care” and to not only attend class, but to “excel in those classes.” She expressed the importance of academic performance, pride in appearance, positive attitudes, establishing connections and collaborations, and developing effective communication skills.

According to President Richardson, Henegan delivered the “most profound address” about embracing our inner abilities.
