

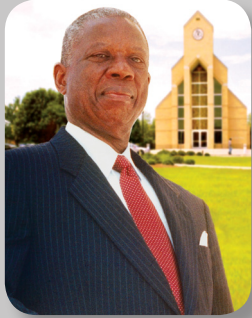

Wheeler Convicts Class of 2013

Upward Bound Counselor and Director of the college's Call Me MISTER Program, Mr. Rudolph Wheeler, did an outstanding job rallying the junior class to standards of excellence as he spoke at their assembly.

He began by enlightening the campus community that most of us operate according to the vision that we have of ourselves as opposed to operating based on our potential. He expounded that this is usually the result of struggles and negative past experiences guiding our view. He advised that an individual must know that they are "worth the effort to succeed." Stating, "I know there is greatness in each of you. Each of you has the potential to set the standard. Most people succeed because they are determined to succeed."

Wanting to evaluate the standard of excellence, Wheeler depicted a jury trial setting to the Class of 2013 and the audience, swearing in members of the audience as the jury and presenting five charges against the class. The verdict would determine if they are meeting the standards of excellence the college set in 1908: "Enter to Learn, Depart to Serve."

Portraying the judge as well as the prosecuting attorney, Wheeler said "The evidence will convict you. I am seeking a guilty verdict. I have a five count indictment against the Class of 2013." He said, "A guilty verdict will set you free, free to pursue academic and professional fulfillment, free to attend graduate school, and free to be on the short-list for interviews after you graduate."

Wheeler went on to present the question before the court, "Is there enough evidence to convict the Class of 2013 of setting the standard of excellence?" Presenting the five counts in question form he asked, **1. Are you choosing the right attitude? 2. Are you making sacrifices?**

3. Are your relationships helping you to grow?
4. Are you guilty of a commitment to excellence?
5. Are you guilty of using your talents and gifts?"

Briefly, Wheeler took the class and the audience from the court room to a short funeral to bury excuses accompanied by "Would have," "Should have," and "But".

Speaking on the fifth count, attempting to live their dreams, he warned students as their life journey ends "Do not to have unfulfilled dreams standing by your bedside crying out, 'We must die with you forever'." Wheeler instructed, "Make sure that you do all you can to fulfill your dreams. Be all that you can be. Let the jury come back with a verdict of guilty on all charges. Let the evidence show the Class of 2013 has been found guilty of setting standards of excellence."

President Richardson gave closing remarks, thanking the junior class and challenging them to set standards of excellence by doing their best. He also thanked Wheeler and complimented him on being both a creative and thought provoking speaker.

BSU HALLELUJAH EXPLOSION

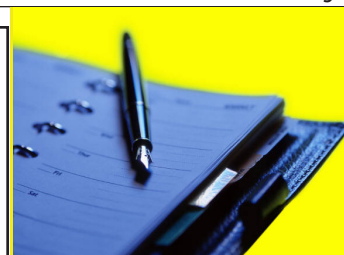
