

ATTIRE FOR CLASS NIGHT AND COMMENCEMENT
(The attire is traditional and all participants must adhere to it).

Class Night: all graduating seniors are asked to participate

- Women:** white or black dress with sleeves (modest style, not too short or tight) or white or black suit; white, off-white or black shoes (*no sandals*), depending on dress or suit color; natural or dark hose, small earrings.
- Men:** dark suit (or dark jacket and slacks; preferably black or navy), white shirt, dark tie, dark socks and shoes.
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Commencement: all graduating seniors are required to participate unless the Vice President for Academic Affairs/Academic Dean is notified in writing that you will not participate

- Men:** dark slacks, white shirt, dark tie, dark socks, and black shoes
- Women:** black or dark dress and black (dress) shoes (*no sandals*), natural or dark hose, small earrings
- Everyone:** bring a small safety pin to hold your hood in place and bobby pins to hold your cap in place

Stoles (optional) - Greek, Morris College, African-American, or Honor Societies are the only stoles permitted. Only one stole can be worn with the cap and gown. All graduating members of each fraternity or sorority must have the same stole style. (*For example: If there are three AKA's and they elect to wear a stole, all three must decide which stole they will order, so that all of the AKA stoles will be the same style*).
