Dr. Deloris Y. McBride has been employed with Morris College for the past 24 years. She was awarded Faculty of the Year twice (2003 and 2007) and the Excellence in Teaching Award in 2007 by the South Carolina Independent Colleges and Universities.

Dr. McBride's teaching opportunities have spanned more than 30 years to include business, technology, and cybersecurity. Dr. McBride has been actively engaged in faculty technology development training as a facilitator. Faculty members were trained using the Learning Management System that the college uses (Jenzabar). She holds certifications in Microsoft Office and cybersecurity. She has published two books, *Learning Computer Basics* and *Living and Growing God's Way*. Her research is being cited by others.

In 2017, she was selected to participate in Google's Faculty In-Residency Program. This six-week inaugural program brought computer science professors from Historically Black Colleges and Universities HBCUs together in one environment. Participating faculty had opportunities to develop professionally by taking various courses such as Machine Learning and Software Development.

Dr. McBride is a proud graduate of Morris College and a life member of the Morris College Alumni Association. As a result of her matriculation at Morris College, she was awarded a full scholarship to attend the Ohio State University completing her first Master's in Business Education. Since then, she has completed a second Master of Arts degree in Computer Resource Management from Webster University and participated in two doctoral programs - Nova Southeastern – DSS Information Systems) and Capitol Technology University earning a Ph.D. in Technology.

Dr. McBride is a licensed minister with the Church of God by Faith where she serves as the Director of the National Board of Christian Education, Global Missions board member, CTI (COGBF Theological Institute) professor, and founder of Faith Outreach Center. She has received numerous recognitions including TWIN 2009, UNCF 360 Leadership Development Project Recipient, and Phi Delta Kappa Charter member to name a few. She showed dedication to the Service Learning Program which she was instrumental in starting at Morris College involving hundreds of students, and more than 30 faculty in service learning projects with the engagement of more than 60 agencies and organizations. Dr. McBride served as the secretary for the Accreditation Council of Business Schools and Program (ACBSP) Region 3 and currently serves as Chair-Elect. She also serves as the Institutional Representative for the South Women in Higher Education. She has traveled to 14 countries spanning four continents and is passionate about assisting others. Her motto is "Blessed to Bless".

Dr. McBride is a past advisor to the Sophomore Class and currently serves as the advisor for Delta Mu Delta International Honor Society, NCNW Morris College Section Advisor, and Co-Advisor for Phi Beta Lambda (FBLA). She is a life member of the National Council of Negro Women and an aspiring life member of the NAACP.
