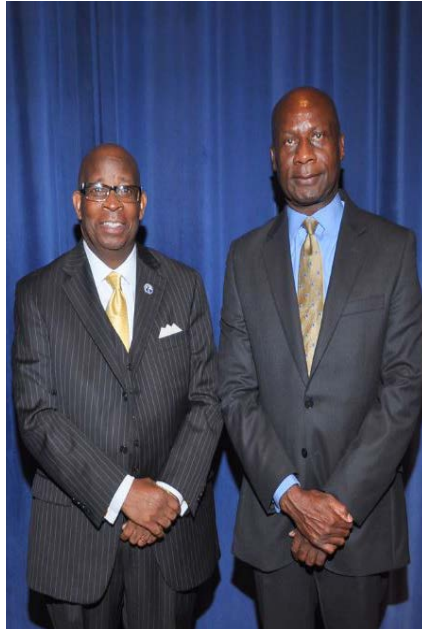

This year's pledges totaled \$25,268.88 of which \$16,770.00 was from faculty and staff and \$8,498.88 was from the student-body. Dr. Leroy Staggers, Interim President, led by example and pledged \$3,000.00.

As a part of the program, the Faculty/Staff Challenge was issued by Dr. Jacob Butler, Jr. where asked Faculty/Staff "If we don't take care of us, who will?" 2017-2018 SGA President Alton Butts, urged his peers by stating "We have to invest in Morris College, because Morris College invests in us." Dr. James Blasingame, President of the Baptist E&M Convention gave remarks regarding the importance of the Fall Harvest Rally and the charge that has been set out to the convention to raise 1 Million dollars for Morris College this year. Annually, the kick-off assembly's dual purpose is to kick-off the Annual Fall Harvest Rally and to comply with the UNCF requirement that each member institution conduct an annual drive. The institution has set a goal of \$35,000.00 and the college is well on its way to reaching that goal.

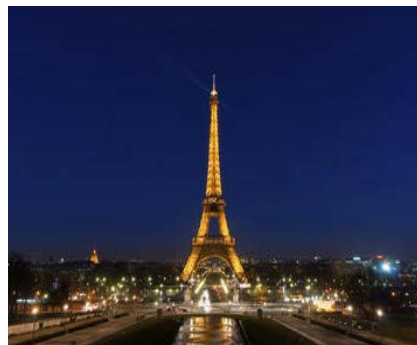
CAMPUS WIDE INSTITUTIONAL SERVICE DAY FEATURING STEM SOFT SKILLS SEMINAR
