Sumter, SC- On Monday, December 16, 2024, at 3:00 PM, Morris College will host government officials such as Representatives J. Williams, Darlington District 62 and others as they present a \$1 million check to Morris College's Higher Education Excellence Enhancement Program or HEEEP.
