Counselor in the office Student Support Services

IMMEDIATE OPENING FOR COUNSELOR POSITION in the Office of Student Support Services: This is a twelve-month full time grant-funded position that will assist the College and the Project Director in implementing the Student Support Services program. The successful candidate must be able to provide academic, social and personal counseling for 200 SSS participating students. This position augments and reinforces counseling services provided elsewhere at the institution with an emphasis on academic success and financial literacy/responsibility. The counselor also tracks academic progress from college entry to graduation.

QUALIFICATIONS: An advanced degree in Counseling or an undergraduate degree in Counseling along with an advanced degree in Psychology, Educational Administration, Developmental Education or other appropriate field of study; two or more years of successful counseling experience in an academic setting. A person with a similar background to TRiO participants (low-income and/or first-generation and students with disabilities) and a strong interest in serving disadvantaged students is preferred.
