

HOW DO I GET TEXTBOOKS FOR MY CLASSES?

Having your textbook sets you up for success in your classes! There are several ways you can get textbooks:

1. **The Morris College Bookstore.** The campus bookstore is a great place to get your textbooks. Although students won't be on campus for the fall 2020 semester due to COVID-19, **students will be allowed to visit the Bookstore until September 4th from 9 am to 1 pm, Monday-Friday.** Please call Ms. Moses-Holmes at (803) 934-3989 or email her at jmholmes@morris.edu to ask about book vouchers. Cash and credit cards are also accepted. The Morris College Bookstore will “ship books if requested”.
2. **Used Books.** Used books are usually way less expensive than new books. You can get them from other students who have taken the course (check out the student network on Facebook) and various sites online such as [Amazon](#), [ebay](#), [Thriftbooks](#), [CheapestTextbooks.com](#), etc.
3. **Rent Books.** Renting your textbook is a great way to get your book for the semester without being stuck with it afterwards. Many sites online offer this option but [Chegg](#) is one of the more popular ones.
4. **E-books.** E-books are another viable option and are often cheaper than purchasing a physical textbook. There are also open source e-book sites such as [Openstax](#). Sites like these allow you to access books for free but selections are limited.
