Sumter, S.C.- On Friday, November 1, 2024, Morris College unveiled the new name change of West College Street. The main road coming into Morris' campus will now be named Dr. Luns C. Richardson Boulevard. On several occasions, Dr. Richardson has been named a monumental element of Morris College's rich history. Richardson served as president of Morris College for over 40 years breaking barriers and changing lives for the better. Many alumni often pay homage to Richardson for the way he led Morris College during his tenure. The unveiling event was held at 9:30 A.M. on the campus ahead of the 2024 homecoming season that began on Friday evening.
